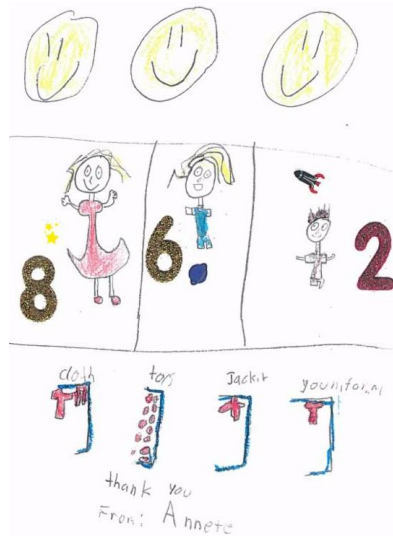

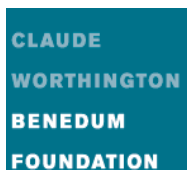

Donor of the Quarter: Delta Enterprises

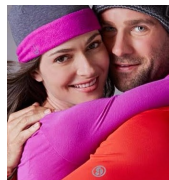
